Notes: HSV infection occurs world wide. The incubation period following exposure is about one week (range 2 to 26 days). HSV 1 & 2 viruses serotypes a fir degree of cross - reactivity. Infection with one virus may also result in a high antibody titre against the heterologous serotype. Presence of IgG does not indicate reinfection, recurrent infection or immunity.
